The United Nations had declared 21 February as the "International Mother Language Day" in the year 2002, in order to protect the vernacular languages and promote their usage all over the world. Since, the fight for the protection of vernaculars began in Bangladesh and was fought in order to promote Bengali, the day is of more significance to the people of West Bengal, more than it is to the other people around the world.

Farewell Programme of the Bengali Department.

The SSA has been operational since 2000-2001, however its roots go back to 1993-1994 when the District Primary Education programme was launched with an aim of achieving the objective of universal primary education. 85% of the expenditure on the programme is borne by the Central Government whereas the other 15% of the expenditure is incurred by the State Governments. The main objectives of the SSA was to establish new schools in places with no schooling facilities, strengthen the existing infrastructure of schools, provide quality elementary education to all the students below the age of 14 years, provide uniforms and other basic necessities of education to school children, increase the number of teaching staff in all the Government schools and even promote girls' education to bring a change in the status of women. The SSA also promoted education of children with special needs and disabilities and also provided equal educational opportunities to children of households belonging to SC/ST, landless agricultural labourers, the Muslim minority, etc.

Debate on "Equity and Equality"

On 7 February 2018 the first-year students of the Education Department had all participated in a debate session which was on the topic of "Equity or Equality". This was not a competition but was rather an interesting and interactive way of learning about the basic differences between the two concepts of equality and equity.
