One Day State level Webinar on "PANDEMIC OUTSIDE, EFFECTS INSIDE – DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, PRESENT CHALLENGES AND HOPE : A SOCIOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVE"

On 21 July 2020, the Department of Sociology at Barasta College organised a One Day State level Webinar on "PANDEMIC OUTSIDE, EFFECTS INSIDE – DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, PRESENT CHALLENGES AND HOPE: A SOCIOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVE."
