A Special Lecture on "Data Recovery"

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Special lecture on "Scope of geography students in urban and regional planning" in the Geography department

On 06 January 2022, at 11:45 AM, a special lecture was conducted by Prof. Prateeti Bandyopadhyay in the Geography Department, room number 13. The lecture was attended by the 5th-semester students of the Geography department. The main focus of the lecture was on the scope of geography students in urban and regional planning.

Prof. Prateeti Bandyopadhyay emphasized that knowledge of geography is essential for an urban planner. With Geographic Information System (GIS), map data is coded in various ways, and residential, commercial, or industrial parcels of land are assigned their own special code. These codes can be further subdivided into more specific categories to show the city's physical features. In analyzing the future population growth of an area, a geographer should study the regional environment, which offers certain resources that can be compared with similar environments and resources known in other parts of the world.

<u>Special lecture on "Role of geography in covid management" in the Geography department</u>

On 07 March 2022, at 12:00 PM, a special lecture was conducted by Prof. Prateeti Bandyopadhyay in the Geography Department, room number 13. The course was attended by the 3rd and 5th-semester students of the Geography department. The study's main focus was on geography's role in COVID management.

Prof. Prateeti Bandyopadhyay emphasised the importance of geography in understanding the spread of the virus and predicting the areas that are at a higher risk of an outbreak. Using GIS, geographers can map the spread of the virus, analyse the demographics of the affected population, and understand the relationships between the virus and environmental factors such as air quality and temperature.

In COVID management, geographers play a critical role in tracking the spread of the virus, identifying hotspots, and understanding the factors that contribute to the outbreak. They can use their expertise in demographic analysis, spatial analysis, and cartography to provide essential insights for decision-makers. For example, geographers can use GIS to create interactive maps that display the number of confirmed cases, hospital bed capacities, and the availability of personal protective equipment in different regions. This information can be used to allocate resources and prioritise interventions to areas where they are needed the most.

A Special lecture on "History of Mapmaking in India" in the Geography department

On 15 March 2022, at 02:00 PM, a special lecture was conducted by Dr Paramita Banerjee in the Geography Department, room number 13. The lecture was attended by the 3rd and 5th-semester students of the Geography department. The main focus of the study was on the history of map-making in India.

Dr Paramita Banerjee emphasised that the history of map making in India goes back to ancient times when maps were drawn by hand, depicting the physical and cultural features of the land. These early maps were used for navigation, land ownership, and religious purposes. During the medieval period, maps became more accurate using mathematical calculations and satellite imagery. With the advent of British rule, cartography in India reached new heights, and maps were used for administrative purposes, military strategy, and territorial expansion.

Special lecture on "Education policies in British-India" in the HISTORY department

On 10 December 2021, at 10:00 AM, a special lecture was conducted by Professor in the History Department, room number 36. The 5th-semester students of the History department attended the class. The main focus of the lecture was on the Education policies in British-India.

On 12 February 2022, at 11:30 AM, the Mathematics Department hosted a special lecture by Prof. Dolanchampa Barman Ray on the topic of "Paradoxes of Infinity". The lecture was attended by students from the 3rd and 5th semesters.

The lecture took place in room number 34, and students were captivated by Prof. Barman Ray's discussion on the paradoxes that arise from the concept of infinity in mathematics. The lecture highlighted that infinity feels like a number, yet it does not behave like one. Prof. Barman Ray discussed how you could add or subtract any finite number to infinity, and the result is still the same infinity, yet all infinities are not created equal.

Paradoxes of infinity is a fascinating and challenging topic in mathematics that deals with the concept of infinity and the various paradoxes that arise from its interpretation and usage. Infinity is a unique mathematical entity that is not a finite number but behaves like one in certain contexts. However, this behaviour leads to many paradoxes when dealing with infinity in a rigorous mathematical sense.

<u>Special lecture on "Social and Political Philosophy" in the Philosophy department</u>
